Course Outline

Description:

The course will introduce general and specific components of male and female leadership styles, differences in effective communication, how to create a high power stance for successful leadership, discussing interpersonal skills required to manage and advance effectively, and reviewing how gender affects our leadership globally.

The course will be presented in a series of workshops, interactive discussion groups, Q & A's and lecture style sessions. It is intended that participants will bring their own experiences, opinions and perspectives to class and benefit from the skills and backgrounds of each other, as well as from the instructor and a series of guest speakers.

Course Goals: To create an understanding and knowledge of how diversity in gender affects leadership. The challenges and opportunities for each will be explored.

Course Objectives:

- 1) Understand the differences in male and female leadership and communication styles
- 2) Identify strategies to enhance your advancement into leadership positions
- 3) Review high and low power stances in regards to successful leadership
- 4) Review global issues in leadership
