Course Outline - Online

Description:

Some of the most treasured works of art have come from the hands and minds of artists who have experienced significant psychological and/or physical illnesses. We will explore the effects of these illnesses, and how they have contributed to the legacies of Vincent van Gogh, Toulouse-Lautrec, Edvard Munch, Frida Kahlo, Canadian Maud Lewis, and many more artistic figures.

Course Goals:

- For the student to appreciate the way in which artists' physical and mental illnesses have often dictated their personal and artistic lives
- For the student to think about whether suffering actually contributes to or hinders artists' creativity

Course Objectives: At the completion of this course, the student will be able to:

- Generally identify the artistic styles of various artists
- Have a greater understanding of how physical and mental illness can affect the lives and artistic production of various artists
- Consider how issues of gender play a role in the perception of artists and their illnesses
