#### **Course Outline**

**Description: Description:** A continuation of the French at Noon: the Basics 1. This course develops the skills acquired in The Basics 1. Expand your vocabulary, grammar, and pronunciation. In Basics 2 you will also expand your oral communication and listening skills via practical situations. French at Noon gives you the advantage of a leisurely pace and a smaller class.

**Course Goals:** In part 1 we studied <u>some basic knowledge</u> of the French language, for example: "L'alphabet, les nombres, le nom, l'adjectif, les verbes AVOIR, ÊTRE, FAIRE, les verbes en ER et le vocabulaire: la classe, la <u>famille</u>". Now in part 2 we will add more <u>Basic French vocabulary</u> like...,(house, city, food). <u>Verbs</u>, <u>(aller, venir, vouloir, pouvoir)</u>. Useful expressions like possessions and...Time and Date. And also practical situations to be used for practice and in-class interaction- <u>(order</u> food and drinks, ask for directions...).

**Course Objectives:** At the completion of this course, the student will be able to: to recognize more expressions and use them by asking and answering questions.
